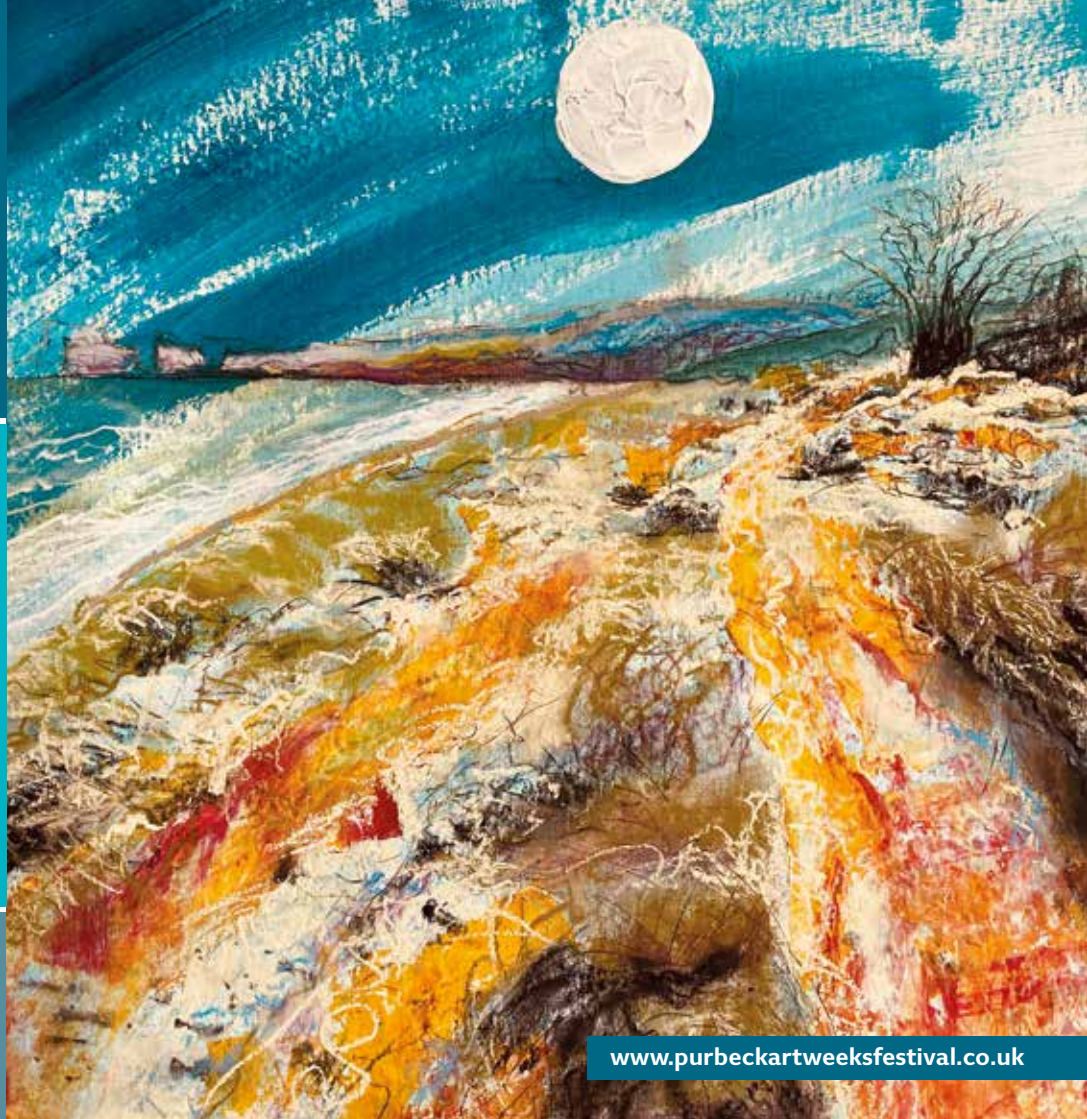

Our painters, sculptors, printers, glass artists and more, are all looking forward to welcoming you to their **Open Studios. Rollington Barn** (near Corfe Castle) hosts our eclectic collective exhibition – and you can find out about our Concerts, other events and more from our stewards there too. It's a great place to start your visit – you'll find the **Courtyard Café** perfect for light lunches, coffee and wow factor cakes! You can spot various artists in action in the **Pop-Up Studio** tent, and in the adjacent byre you'll find a display of imaginative work by young people involved in our **Purbeck Young Artists** workshop scheme.

bring a selection of Dowland's songs and more, as well as two world premieres. We close with **The Gesualdo Six** vocal ensemble, back by popular demand.

We are delighted that our PAW President and distinguished sculptor **Philip Jackson** will be speaking on The Changing Face of Beauty. Visiting artists' studios is a wonderful way to enjoy the range of art produced across the Isle of Purbeck. We have painters, printmakers, sculptors, metal workers, ceramicists, wood workers, jewellers, textile artists and much more for you to explore. Our artists are looking forward to welcoming you!






Entry to all studios and exhibitions is free.

Look out for the small yellow and blue PAW direction signs – or have a look at the PAW map on the back of your brochure and plan your trail around your tastes, timescale, or transport. More information will be available on suggested trails at Rollington Barn. There is a good local bus service as well as the Swanage Railway steam train, and bicycles can be hired at Wareham Station.

You may like to take your debit or credit card with you (or cheque book) just in case temptation strikes. Many Open Studios have card machines, but not all. Or you can secure your latest art-related purchase by paying a deposit.

Please respect individual Open Studios' guidance to visitors. ## IN THE SUMMERTIME... GAWAIN GLENTON WITH IN ECHO

### Johann Sommer and the 17th-century German sonata

Johann Sommer was a virtuoso violinist based in Bremen. His punningly-titled 1623 collection of instrumental sonatas, *Fröhliche Sommerzeit*, contains some of the most inventive writing for two, three and even four violins – or cornettos. In this concert, **Gawain Glenton** returns to Purbeck with **In Echo**, an ensemble of cornettos, violins, violas, violone and organ, to show off the playfulness and virtuosity of North German instrumental music with music by Sommer and his contemporaries, Samuel Scheidt and Johann Vierdanck – as well as the ensemble's own take on Johann Pachelbel's famous *Canon in D*.

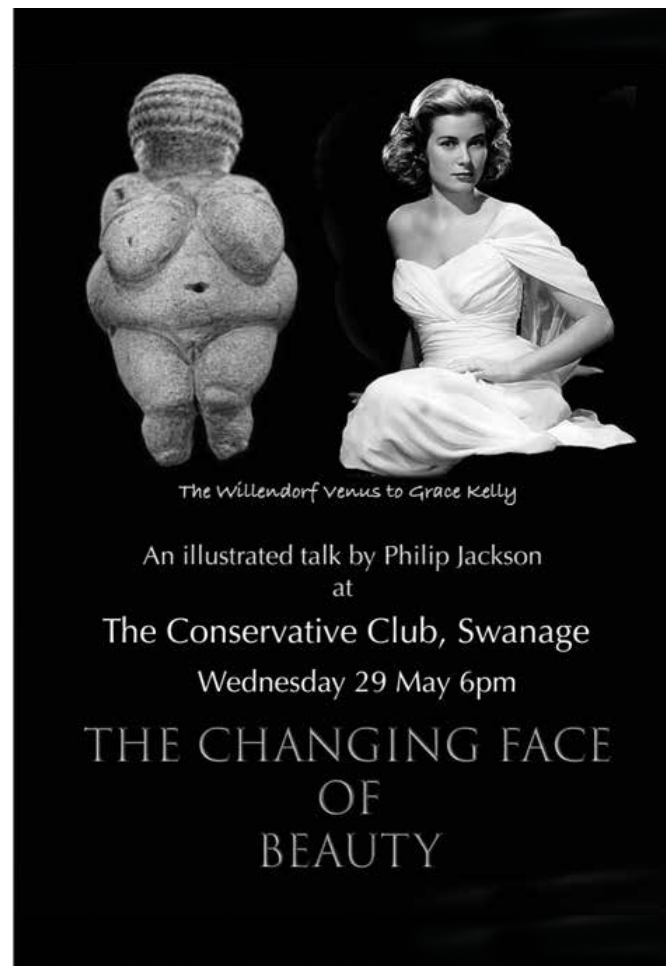

## FROM VENICE (TO ROME), WITH LOVE I FAGIOLINI

In the 1640s Claudio Monteverdi, maestro of St. Mark’s Venice, entered the last few years of his life, having produced works in both the impressive multi-choir style as well as intimate miniatures for solo voices. Both these styles were copied all over Europe, including Rome, where Orazio Benevoli produced outsize masses for *four separate choirs*, to be sung around the huge altar space of Michelangelo’s recently finished St Peter’s Basilica.

**I Fagiolini** return to bring us a sumptuous programme featuring such a Roman Mass, with the four choirs, split around the church, tossing their phrases from one to another. In a much more intimate style, Giacomo Carissimi’s short oratorio tells the heart-rending tale of Jephtha and his daughter, with echo effects and one of the finest choruses of the entire 17th century. The programme also includes some of Monteverdi’s greatest ensemble and solo works from Venice.

## Purbeck Young Artists Scheme

The very essence of PAW is to pass on a passion for art to the young people in our community. We are aware that art in schools has been cut over the years, and we feel that our special role is to encourage youngsters to enjoy the benefits of getting involved and experiment in making art. We work closely with local schools to celebrate and encourage art, and each year we try and involve around 500 Purbeck Young Artists (PYA) in creative activities. This year we have a record number of 18 schools participating.

The workshops have been coordinated by local artist and teacher Sophie Jenkins, and are delivered by an amazing team of 6 local artists with a wealth of experience of working with young people. This year, students have been encouraged to develop art works on the theme of 'Coastal Life' – through a range of workshops including, glass art, puppet making, painting banners, clay making, graffiti street art and 3D art using recycled materials. You can see the inspiring results in the byre at Rollington Barn.

We would, as always, like to express our heartfelt thanks to the Friends of the Festival and to all our Sponsors for supporting our work with young people. Without their amazing generosity we would not have so many opportunities to spread the enjoyment of art so widely. We would also like to thank the schools and teachers involved this year for recognising the importance of art and creativity for young people and helping to produce some incredible work.
